
## Replace the fuse

- a) Grasp plug and remove from the receptacle or other outlet device, do not unplug by pulling on cord.
- b) Open fuse cover. Slide open fuse access cover on top of attachment plug towards blades.
- c) Remove fuses carefully.
- d) Risk of fire. Replace fuses with 5 Amp, 125 Volt fuses.
- e) Close fuse cover. Slide closed the fuse access cover on top of attachment plug.
- f) Risk of fire. Do not replace attachment plug. Contains a safety device (fuse) that should not be removed. Discard product if the attachment plug is damaged.


Replace only with same type 7 watt max, condelabre-base UL Classified lamps.

CAUTION To reduce the risk of fire do not deliberately reposition either lampholder contact.

### INSTRUCTION

- 1. Assemble A tube, B tube and C tube well, Use screws fasten them firmly.
- 2. Use plastic ties tie up the String Light on Tubes.
- 3. Refer to fig 3 lie down Tube, Tube through the ring under the cane lantern top to the end.
- 4. Assemble C tube with Base well, use screws fasten them firmly.
- 5. Is a cleek on the base, use it hook on the bottom of candy cane.
- 6. Use velcro stick bowknot on candy cane.

m) This product has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) as a feature to reduce the risk of electric shock, This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug, If it still does not fit, contact a gualified electrician, Do not use with an extension cord unless plug can be fully inserted. Do not alter or replace the plug.

n ) This product employs overload protection(fuse). A blown fuse indicates an overload or short-circuit situation. If the fuse blows, unplug the product from the outlet. Also unplug any additional strings or products that may be attached to the product. Replace the fuse as per the user servicing instructions (follow product marking for proper fuse rating)and check the product. If the replacement fuse blows, a short-circuit may be present and the product should be discarded.

o) Read and follow all instructions that are on the product or provided with the product.

# E THESE INSTRUCTIONS

- a. When the product is placed on a live tree, the tree should be well maintained and fresh, Do not place on live trees in which the needles are brown or break off easily, Keep the tree holder filled with water.
- b. If the product is placed on a tree, the tree should be well secured and stable.
- c.Before using or reusing,inspect carefully. Discard any products that have cut,daaged, or frayed wire insulation or cords, cracks in the lamp holders or enclosures; loose connections. or exposed copper wire.
- d. When storing the product, carefully remove the product from wherever it is placed.

Including trees, branches, or bushes, to avoid any undue strain or stress on the product, conductors, connections and wires.

e.When not in use, store neatly in a cool dry location protected from sunlight.
